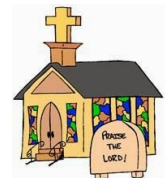

There will be no St. Rita Rosary Society meetings during the summer months. Will resume again in September



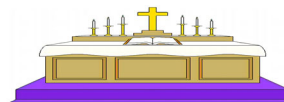
If you know any parishioner who is homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion, please call the Rectory with their name, address and phone number and we will bring the Eucharist to them at home.

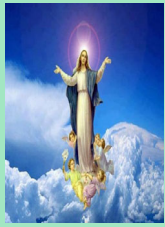
OUR LADY OF FATIMA STATUE

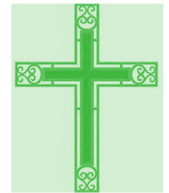
